- 4. Must possess good organizational skills and be able to prepare the educational material required for the Judging Schools
- 5. Must know the techniques used to produce the articles to be judged;
- 6. Need desire, interest, good common sense, be fair but flexible and maintain a high standard of workmanship
- 7. Must support, endorse and follow the "Homecraft Judging Standards for Ontario Fairs" and/or "Agriculture and Horticulture Judging Standards for Ontario Fairs".
- 8. Must sign and abide by the "OAAS Judges and Instructors Code of Conduct and Code of Ethics"
- 9. Must be able to travel.
- 10. May instruct in any District including their own.

- 11. Maintains ongoing communication with OAAS Judging Panel
- 12. Once you have completed both apprenticeships, forward this completed form to the OAAS to be eligible to be added to the "Certified Instructors" List.
